




East (and West)










Road Toll

- Northern Territory 27 deaths per 100,000

Reasons for not using public transport - 2003 Study




















A bit of perspective

Bodhi Bus in Katherine

- Lajamanu -Katherine (one way):
- Adults \$160
- Concession \$150
- □ Child \$90
- Family of 4 return journey = \$1000

Centre Bush Bus in Alice Springs

- Pipalyatjara -Alice Springs (one way):
- Adults \$180
- Concession \$170
- Child \$120
- Family of 4 return journey = \$1200
- You might be better off buying a car!
