registered charities work in the NT.

68% of these are categorised as small to medium, with 51% with an income of less than \$250,000 per year.



are employed (full and part time) in NT charities.

That's 8% of the NT workforce, and more than the manufacturing and mining sectors combined.



main activities undertaken by NT charities are:

- Economic, social, community development
- Religious activities
- Culture and arts



is the total annual income of NT charities. 51% of this income comes from operations and donations.



of NT not-for-profit organisations are supported by volunteer workers.

\$417m of paid employee expenses is fed back into the NT economy.

Employees generally spend in the local geographical area in which their organisation operates.
