## Clinical Assessment Overview- Optional

- 40–50 hours of supervised clinical training, where learners are supported to apply their theoretical knowledge in a clinical setting to further develop reproductive and sexual health (R&SH) practice.
- Must be completed within 12 months of obtaining the Certificate in Reproductive & Sexual Health for Nurses (Theory).
- Additional fees will apply if you choose this option.
- Please enquire at the time of enrolment, as availability is subject to the capacity and availability of FPWNT staff members.

## Certification

- Certificate in Reproductive & Sexual Health for Nurses (Clinical) will be issued on successful completion of the clinical requirements outlined above.
- This certification is recognised within Family Planning Organisations across Australia.
